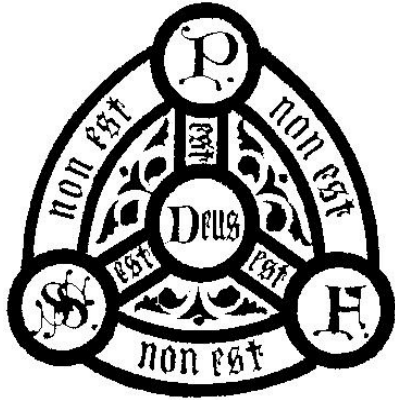

Corporate Confession
